

TRAVEL AWARD COMPETITION, 2024

FOR QUINTA STUDENTS OF GYMNÁZIUM BOŽENY NĚMCOVÉ

The prize for the 2024 UK travel competition will be 15,000 Czech crowns.

The competition is open to students in their penultimate year, Quinta, at Gybon in the academic year 2023-2024 and will be organised by Mr. Pavel Adámek.

The aim of the competition is to enable the winner to travel to England/the UK any time between the start of May and the end of August 2024 and there to speak, listen to and understand English.

The judging panel this year is

Julian Wilde, former Principal of King Edward and Queen School in Lytham, UK who has visited Gybon many times over the past 30 years to teach English.

Johana Macková who was winner of the first travel award at Gybon in 2011. Johana, the current Czech Skimo champion, has recently opened Uphill, her own sports clothing shop in Trutnov.





Lady Milena Grenfell-Baines visited Gybon in 2014 to give her personal account of her escape from Prague as a Winton child in 1939. She continues to give talks about Sir Nicholas Winton and the kindertransport and promotes links of every sort between the Czech Republic and the UK.

Full information about the travel competition will be announced to students by the Headmaster Mr. Jan Šterba and all the English teachers at Gybon on November 20th.
